

## Poor Weather Condition Guidelines 2020

The following guidelines detail the arrangements for visits during poor weather conditions.

Type of Warning Hoisted	May continue <sup>1</sup>	Cancel <sup>2</sup>
Very hot weather warning	✓	
Regional strong wind	✓	
Thunderstorm <sup>3</sup>	✓	
Amber rainstorm	✓	
Red or black rainstorm		✓
Strong monsoon signal	✓	
Typhoon signal no. 1	✓	
Typhoon signal no. 3 or above		✓
Air Quality Health Index 10 or above		✓
Close school announced by the EDB		✓

In addition to the above guidelines, factors such as wind force, swell, fog, etc will be taken into consideration.

### Footnotes:

<sup>1</sup> May continue means depending on the weather forecast. Our team will discuss the arrangements with the organiser approximately two hours before the start of the activity, or during the activity as required, but the former will make the final decision to continue or cancel the activity.

<sup>2</sup> This will be conveyed to the organiser approximately two hours before the start of the activity. If this warning is hoisted during the activity, the activity will be suspended.

<sup>3</sup> If there is a thunderstorm warning hoisted but there is no thunderstorm activity in the area, the activity may continue at the discretion of PFS and agreement by the organiser.
